Community Gallery Information

The Community Gallery at Red River Theatres features a local artist each month. Located between the two large theaters, the gallery is a popular space in the theater and adds to the community atmosphere. Artists with all mediums of work that can be hung are encouraged to apply.

Details of Installation

Art in the community gallery is on display for one month only. Hanging and takedown dates are coordinated upon acceptance. Artists are expected to curate their own exhibit and provide hanging hardware and item tags. In lieu of payment for the space, artists donate 1 piece of artwork to Red River to be auctioned off later, with the proceeds going to the Red River.

The gallery consists of two walls. One panel space is 13 ft long and the other panel is 12 ft long. Each panel has an 18" high self-healing mat for hanging. Hardware may only be placed in the self healing mat but artwork can overhang that area.

The Red River Theatres will provide the gallery space for one month, a listing on the Red River Theatres' website, and promotion in the Flick Flash and Weekly Flyer. There will also be promotion through Art Concord.

The Artist agrees to provide the artwork for display, hardware for hanging, a bio, sample images for promotion, a donation of 1 piece to the Red River, and an artist statement.

Application Process

Starting for the 2012 exhibition season, Red River Theatres will ask for local artists to apply from June 1-30, 2011. Artists for the 2012 season will be announced by September 1, 2011.

Artists are asked to provide the following:

- Completed Artist Information Sheet
- Sample images of 2 pieces
- Artist Statement
- Artist Biography

Please note: Once an artist has exhibited, they must wait a full exhibition season before showing again.
